Dear Year 10 Parent/Carer,

Year 10 Progress Evening – 16th March 2023

Key stage 4 is the most time in your child's education at high school and quite possibly the most important years of their lives. For that reason, we want to start early! We understand year 10 can be daunting, without the added pressure caused by gaps in student learning during the pandemic. We wish to support both pupils and parents throughout the process. We want to ensure that we keep you informed about the progress of your child, and to enable you to support and motivate them to achieve a set of qualifications that reflect their ability and that they can be proud of.

We are looking to constantly refine our processes and improve our communications and to that end we are adding an additional progress evening for year 10 students on **Thursday 16th March at 5:00pm**. Parents attend with their child to collect their most recent report and receive key information to support your child over the next 18 months.

There will be a presentation delivered in the hall at 6:00pm and there will be the opportunity after the presentation for you to meet with Mr Adcroft, myself and other members of the senior leadership team. The evening will last no longer than one hour.

The purpose of the evening will be to inform you of:

- Your child's progress and if they are achieving grades in line with their pathway (based on recent teacher assessments and January year 10 mock examinations)
- The increased importance of year 10 summer mock examinations
- What you can do to aid your child if they are underachieving
- What will happen during key stage 4
- Generic revision techniques and exam preparation
- Specific revision strategies for English, Maths and Science
- The full programme of intervention at Darwen Vale
- The opportunity to look at revision guides and materials available for your child throughout KS4. X
- Information regarding our English and Maths bootcamp.

Parents and students will also have the opportunity on this evening to ask any questions and hopefully relieve any concerns that you may have from myself and Mr Adcroft. This evening does **not** replace the Year 10 parents evening which is on 18th May which is still going ahead 5pm till 7pm.
